

chenille

Technically advanced upholstery fabrics made out of chenille fibres, consisted of two simple twisted-together threads - between which are another cut fibres. Owing to that - fabric has a structure similar to that of velour or plush. A typical feature for the chenille - is an irregularity of upper structure, tiny irregular clearances, and downiness. It is a pile fabric and will flatten as a characteristic. For optimal appearance retention, regular light vacuuming or brushing with a soft brush is necessary.
